How do I apply?

You may be able to access this service if you are an older person, a person living with a disability or a carer having difficulty accessing public transport.

Our Community Transport Coordinator will discuss your transport needs with you, including how far you can walk and how long you can comfortably sit on a bus. This assessment will help us choose the support that is right for you.

You can reach our Community Transport Coordinator between 9:00 and 4:30PM Monday to Friday.

Outside of these hours you are welcome to leave a message at the Centre, and your call will be returned as soon as possible.

My Aged Care

My Aged Care is a service of the Australian Government to help you find your way around the aged care system, and to give you choices, more control and easier access to a range of aged care services.

If you are a carer and wish to access aged care services for the person you care for the first time, you will now need a referral from My Aged Care.

You are welcome to phone us to discuss your needs in the first instance or you can contact My Aged Care directly and nominate us as your preferred service provider.

My Aged Care will then provide you with a referral to South Eastern Community Connect.
