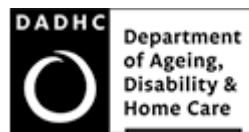

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# Social Support

The South East Neighbourhood Centre is located in Eastlakes in the Botany Local Government Area. It runs many services from Childcare to Aged Care. In particular we are in the process of expanding our Social Support program.

## Who is Eligible?

To be eligible a person must either be Frail Aged, a Carer or have a disability that makes getting out and about difficult.

If you are unsure whether you or someone you want to refer is eligible please contact our Centre and we can discuss your situation.



## How does the service work?

The Social Support service helps the Frail Aged, People with Disabilities and their Carers. It provides Individual Assistance with the following

- Shopping
- Banking
- Bill Paying
- Home Visiting
- Assistance with Medical Appointments

## Other services

- STAR Program (Stroke Talking and Recovery)
- Monthly Social Groups with Guest Speakers

- Monday to Friday 9-5

## How much does it cost?

Individual Assistance is offered for a small fee with a maximum of 2 hours per fortnight.
